- Please use blank lines to describe the agricultural use of your property, i.e. raising cattle, growing crops.
- Acreage use can be filled out to best of your knowledge.
- You may or may not have a FEIN Number and/ or Agricultural Sales Tax Exemption Permit Number.
- Affidavit needs to be stamped by a notary public.
